Rainwater Harvesting and Low Water Use Landscape

The <u>Citizens Water Advocacy Group</u> is cooperating with the Granite Peaks Unitarian Universalist Fellowship to replace a high water use landscape with an attractive low water use landscape and rainwater harvesting system. The project is in progress at this time. When completed, signage will describe the project to the community and school children.
